# **Notice of Race**

Somers Yacht Club as the Organizing Authority invites all Hobie catamaran sailors to enter the 2015 Victorian Hobie Cat State Championships.

# 1. Rules:

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Yachting Australia Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats.
- 1.3 The Rules of the International Hobie Class Association changed as follows:
- 1.4 All as modified by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

# 2. Eligibility and Entry: Warning:

If you participate in these activities your rights to sue the supplier under the Fair Trading Act 1999 if you are killed or injured because the activities were not supplied with due care and skill or were not reasonably fit for their purpose, are excluded, restricted or modified in the way set out in this notice.

Note: The change to your rights, as set out in this notice does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.

Exclusion of implied terms: The terms implied into contracts for the supply of services by virtue of sections 32J and 32 JA of the Fair Trading Act, are hereby expressly excluded from the provision of recreational services by Somers Yacht Club to members and other participants in club activities.

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Hobie catamarans.
- 2.2 All Skippers shall be financial members of an ANHCA affiliated Hobie Cat State Association (or their relevant national IHCA association for international sailors)
- 2.3 All entries shall be on the attached Entry Form.

# 2.4 All sailors are to be a holder of a valid AYF Membership card

#### 3. A minimum of 3 boats shall constitute a class.

# 4. Rights to use names and likeness:

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants HCAV, the Organising Authority and sponsors of the event the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of them during the period of the competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said event without compensation.

#### 5. Fees:

The series entry fee is: \$185 for a two person boat,

\$140 for a one person boat,

\$130 for a youth entry for 2 person boat with both Skipper and Crew under 21

Entries include "race entry", "HCAV skipper membership fee" and "dinner" on Sunday evening for all competitors. Tickets for Sunday evening are available for non-sailors at registration.

All <u>direct bank deposits</u> to be clearly identified with the sender's name; and the deposit slip emailed or posted to the HCAV Secretary.

# 6. Schedule of events:

There will be up to 12 races over 3 days. (Maximum of 5 races per day)

Saturday 7th March 2015 Registration 9:30 - 11:30 am

- Competitors meeting 12:00 am
- Race warning signal not before 1:00 pm
- HCAV AGM at SYC 6:30pm

#### Sunday 8th March 2015

- Race warning signal not before 9.30 am
- HCAV Carvery Roast Dinner 7:00 pm

#### Monday 9th March 2015

- Race warning signal not before 9.30 am
- Last race warning signal not after 2:00 pm
- Presentation ceremony to follow.

#### 7. Measurements.

A measurement certificate is not required with entry form, but it is the responsibility of each skipper to ensure their boat complies with the International Hobie Class Association rules. Measurement checks and inspections may be carried out at any time. A boat notified of inspection shall follow the instructions of the Race Committee.

# 8. Sailing Instructions.

The sailing instructions will be available on registration at Somers Yacht Club from the 7<sup>th</sup> of March and on the Hobie Cat Association website.

# 9. Regatta Site:

The regatta will be sailed on the waters in the vicinity of Somers Yacht Club.

#### 10. The Courses.

All Courses shall be IHCA Standard Courses

# 11. Penalty System.

Rules 41.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

# 12. Scoring.

- 12.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race
- 12.3 When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 12.4 When 11 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

# 13. Communication.

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

# 14. Prizes.

Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of HCAV.

# 15. Disclaimer of Liability:

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

#### 16. Insurance.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million per event or the equivalent. Skippers are required to produce valid insurance certificates.
